Dear Parent

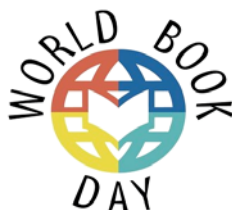
I would like to thank all parents who were able to complete the questionnaire on our Parent Consultation Day.
